The Global Assessment Report 2019 by the UNDRR outlines the efforts to reduce disaster risk worldwide. The latest report underscores *major risks to human life and material property*, ranging from *air pollution* and *biological hazards*, through to *earthquakes*, *drought* and *climate change*, while raising the alarm for *new and emerging risks*, including *Natech accidents*. Governments are urged to adopt appropriate strategies to address such challenges in order to *avoid slowing down or even reversing progress towards the Sustainable Development Goals* (SDGs).
