Global Assessment Report 2019 (GAR2019)

(15 March, 2019)

The Global Assessment Report 2019 by the UNDRR outlines the efforts to reduce disaster risk worldwide. The latest report underscores **major risks to human life and material property**, ranging from *air pollution* and *biological hazards*, through to *earthquakes*, *drought* and *climate change*, while raising the alarm for **new and emerging risks**, including *Natech accidents*. Governments are urged to adopt appropriate strategies to address such challenges in order to **avoid slowing down or even reversing progress towards the Sustainable Development Goals** (SDGs).
